Reservations

- Reservations may be made in person or by mail.
- The earliest opportunity to make reservations is Saturday, April 4th between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. in person at the Recreation Building at the Robert Livermore Community Center, 4444 East Avenue, Livermore. A maximum of two sites may be reserved for any date by persons from the same household.
- Weekdays, beginning April 6th, reservations may be made in person at the Community Building at the Community Center between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

- Advanced reservations for the mobility impaired or those with special medical needs will be taken in person at the Community Building at the Community Center beginning March 30th. Please bring paperwork authorizing your handicapped parking permit or other documentation validating your need.
- No reservations will be taken by phone.

FEES

- Fees are per night, up to 8 people per site.
- There is a \$5 fee for a second vehicle per night.
- No more than two vehicles are allowed per site.

CAMP SHELLY BASICS

Check-in/Check-out

Check-in begins at 2 p.m. Check-out time is noon on the day of your departure.

Food Storage

All food and ice chests must be stored in your campsite's food locker. No food should be left outside unattended at any time. Help us keep our wildlife wild by not feeding them.

Wood and Fires

Stacked wood may be available at the campground for \$5 per wheelbarrow full. Dead wood and kindling lying on the ground may be collected free of charge. Smokey Bear asks that you keep campfires safe. Extinguish fires with water (not dirt) before going to bed or leaving camp. Do not throw trash or food debris in fire pit.

Smoking

Smokey Bear says: "Be careful with cigarettes and matches!" Please clean up cigarette butts and other litter.

Dogs

Dogs must be leashed while in the campground. Pets may not be left unattended. Store pet food in your locker at night and when you leave camp.

Parking

Please park in the designated slot for your site only. Ask the rangers about where to park if you are unsure. Overflow parking may be available near the campground entrance.

Quiet Hours

Please respect the campground quiet hours from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. If you play music at any time of the day, keep the volume low enough that it will not be heard in other sites. Recharging of batteries by generators must be finished by 8 p.m.

Dishes

Dishes should be washed in a basin at your campsite. Do not wash or scrape them at the hose bib or sinks as it attracts animals and yellow jackets. Use biodegradable soap if possible and disperse the wash water at the edge of camp.
