Dear Park Neighbors,

We here at Livermore Area Recreation and Park District (LARPD) and the Livermore Police Department realize it is not always easy to live next to a public park, but rest assured, we want your experience to be an enjoyable one. We are seeking your help to keep your parks in good condition, and safe for you and all our visitors.

As neighbors of the park, you can help identify problems as they first appear. Please help protect the park from abuse and unsafe situations by reporting them to LARPD or the Livermore Police Department.

**Maintenance issues-** when maintenance issues arise, call the LARPD Maintenance Service Center (925) 960-2440, or e-mail Park Supervisor Steve Gregg at [sgregg@larpd.dst.ca.us](mailto:sgregg@larpd.dst.ca.us).

**Emergency situations-** if the Livermore Police Department needs to be called, please have the following information available:

1. Exact location (include cross street)
2. Action occurring
3. Description of subjects involved (be as detailed as possible)
4. Description of vehicles involved (license plate if possible)

**For emergencies, call 9-1-1**

**Local emergencies (recommended number for cell phones) call (925) 371-4987**

**For non-emergencies (925) 371-4900**

**For graffiti call (925) 373-5600. For graffiti in progress call 9-1-1**

**For crime prevention call (925) 371-4797**

**For abandoned vehicles call (925) 371-4824**

The Livermore Police Department and the Livermore-Pleasanton Fire Department respond on a priority basis, depending on what else is happening in the community and what resources are available at the time. They will respond as soon as possible.

LARPD is committed to providing you excellent recreation and park services, however, park improvements are largely contingent on the state budget and fees collected from development projects, as well as property taxes. We hope these revenue sources will improve over the next few years. As this happens, park improvement projects can be planned and implemented.
